Hello all again. We're well into the swing of things now with Easter behind us and the only thing between us and the start of our 2024 footy season being 2 training sessions. With less than one week to go for the Men there's lots of excitement and I think it's fair to say all the players are pretty much ready to start the real stuff after a really positive pre-season program.

Just keep in mind it's Gather Round for the AFL teams this week so there's no better time to watch some great LOCAL footy live. Gather your family and friends and come down to Surrey Park on Saturday and enjoy the weather, the food and drinks and the local footy atmosphere... you can catch the AFL footy any time on Kayo but there's only going to be one time in the history of Surrey Park where we get to unfurl our FIRST Senior Men's Premiership Flag – so don't miss out!

We do have one other big announcement for the club since the previous newsletter - Given the strength of U19 numbers, and to ensure we are providing a football path for the Colts Junior boys, we have decided to field **TWO U19's teams in season 2024**. One U19's team will compete in Division 1 and the other team will compete in Division 3 of the EFNL competition.

Congratulations to Adam Steiner who has been appointed as the coach for the second U19's team. Thanks to the U19's group who have worked hard to ensure they had strong enough jumpers to field the 2 sides – special mention to Noah Caruso, Jordie Currie, Rory Sinclair and Daisy for their extra work to get players signed up. This is the first time Surrey Park has fielded 5 senior teams in one season so please don't be shy in helping to assist – ALL volunteers will be very much welcomed to help us all enjoy the season in supporting our Men & women to be successful.

2024 Practice matches

The Panther teams have taken part in 2 sets of practice matches to date. With the restrictions on local ovals it effectively means we have no choice but to travel to get some practice matches in place and that's what we've done this year. On Saturday 16th we ventured down Cora Lynn (Just under 1 hours drive from Surrey). The Women, and both Men's teams played against Narre Warren while the U19's had a good hitout against Langwarrin. The Women played well for their first hitout and won well against Narre Warren. The



U19's took a quarter or so to settle down then found their groove and won well. The senior teams played 6 quarters across the development and senior squads and showed their significant improvement over the last 12 mths with Narre Warren struggling to score but it was an enjoyable first hitout for all involved.





On 23rd March we headed out to Mary Meade Catholic College in South Morang to take on the South Morang Lions. With South Morang having played finals in the second division of the NFNL we expected to get a tough hitout and that's exactly what we got. The U19's had 15 on the bench that we circulated off the bench and were able to remain competitive against a side that made us earn every ball we won. It was a terrific contest to watch between the clubs. Our reserves were next up and with the team being short of numbers we were

competitive for a half but in the end we were competing 13 against 18 so Sth Morang made us earn

our keep. The Men's senior game was a great contest to watch across 4 quarters, with the lead changing many times during the game, with Sth Morang running out slim winners. Our ladies were last up and it's fair to say we watched them play some of their best team football, with a number of passages of play where they transferred the ball beautifully between players and kicked a number of goals from terrific team play. The ongoing improvement in the Women's skills was on show for all to see and provides lots of positive direction for the season ahead.

Thanks also to Sth Morang football club for being such good hosts – we are hopeful of repeating these pre-season games in the years ahead.


